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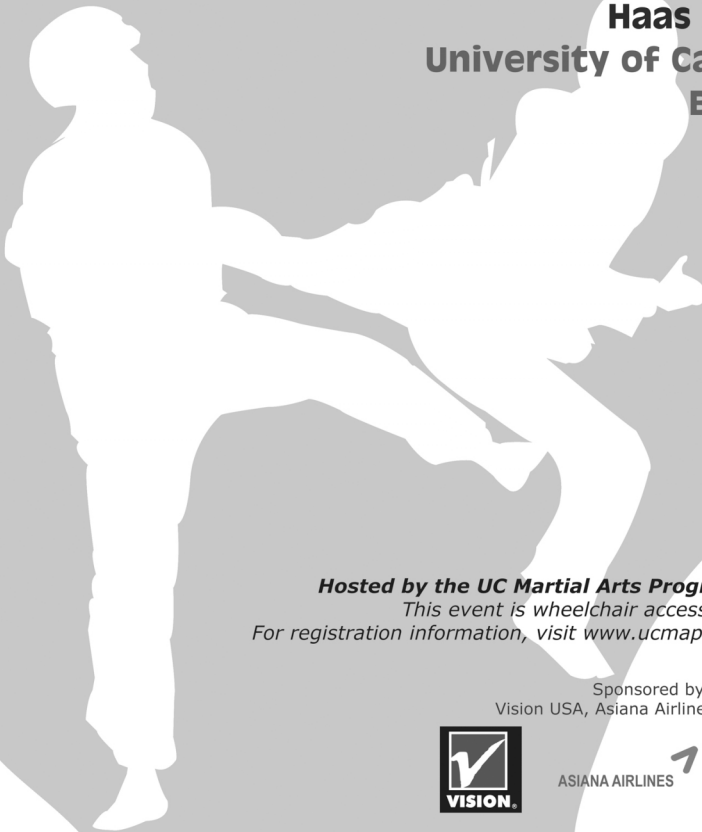

Dear Taekwondo Masters and Families:

On behalf of the UC Berkeley Martial Arts Program, we cordially invite you to attend the 40th Annual UC Open Taekwondo Championship. Since it began 40 years ago, this event has become one of the largest, highest quality, and most popular Taekwondo tournaments on the West Coast. The 40th Annual UC Open will be held on Saturday, May 30, 2009, at Haas Pavilion on the University of California Berkeley campus.

UCMAP History

A prominent feature of the University of California at Berkeley, the UC Martial Arts Program is an expanding, dynamic organization dedicated to providing outstanding martial arts instruction to the campus community. Under the guidance of dedicated individuals such as Dr. Henry Stone, who introduced Judo to UC Berkeley in the 1930s, and Dr. Kyung Ho (Ken) Min, the founder and technical director emeritus of the present martial arts program, UCMAP has grown into an organization that is recognized throughout the world and is a model for other universities.

Since 1969, Dr. Min has utilized his innovative instructional and programming methods and his qualifications in many martial arts (9th Dan Taekwondo, 9th Dan Judo, 9th Dan Yongmudo, 3rd Dan Kendo) to elevate UCMAP to its present status. Instruction in UCMAP clubs is carried out by high-ranking instructors in their particular martial arts, many of whom are themselves students of Dr. Min. The current director is Dr. Russell Ahn, a P.E. faculty member as well as the head coach of the Cal Taekwondo team.

The UC Open Taekwondo Championship was one of the first events created by UCMAP and will celebrate its 40th anniversary in 2009. The UC Open began as a small competition in which Berkeley's taekwondo students could demonstrate and apply the skills they'd learned and test themselves in a stressful but controlled environment. The UC Open has since blossomed into a grand affair, welcoming competitors of all ages from not only the Bay Area but other parts of California as well as other states such as Idaho, Montana, and Kansas.

This year, adult black belt competitors will once again have an opportunity to win a voucher from [Asiana Airlines](#) for a round trip to Korea. The vouchers will be awarded to two female and two male competitors. Good luck to everyone.

Please note that due to the limited capacity of the Haas Pavilion, there will be a cap of 750 competitors for the 40th UC Open. Please make sure to register early online (before April 19th 2009, 11:59 PM PST) in order to reserve your place and receive an instant \$5 discount off your registration fee.

Coaches:	<p>One coach pass will be given for <u>every</u> 10 competitors per school. Additional passes will be available for \$35 each IN ADVANCE from the website and \$50 on the day of the tournament. They will be available for collection at the Haas Pavilion Lobby VIP table on the day of the tournament. Coach passes are non-transferable, and can be revoked at the discretion of the Tournament Director. WEIGH-IN RULES

- Competitor’s weight upon weigh-in must be no greater than the weight stated on the application form and equal to or above the lower weight boundary of the weight division signed up for. Consequently, there will be only one weight division allowed per competitor within each age category.
- A competitor’s weight may be measured twice. If a contestant does not qualify the first time, one more official weigh-in is allowed before the end of weigh-ins, 8.15 am on Saturday, May 30th, 2009.
- Only the competitor may enter the weigh-in area.
- Any irregular action by the competitor or coach during the weigh-in may result in disqualification from tournament participation, in which case there will be **NO REFUND**.

Not exceeding:

The weight limit is defined by the criterion of two decimal places away from the stated limit (in hundredths). For example, “not exceeding 50 kg” goes up to 50.009 kg, with 50.01 kg being over the limit.

Over:

50.01 kg is considered over the 50.00 kg mark; 49.99 kg is considered insufficient.

Official Poomse (Forms) Competition

Creative Poomse:

Creative poomse are only open only to Black Belts, using basic Taekwondo techniques, and a maximum time limit of 2 minutes.

Traditional Poomse:

- All forms must be Kukkiwon/WTF recognized.
- Official Poomse weight divisions for competitors performing Palgwae, Taeguk, and Black Belt Forms will be the same as Gyorooigi weight divisions.

The WTF presently recognizes and requires the following:

The tournament director reserves the right to combine or modify divisions.

Gyoroogi Competition (Free-Sparring)

- All gyoroogi matches will be scored using **electronic scoring** systems (in case of unexpected problems, traditional paper scoring will be implemented).
- There will be single elimination for free-sparring.

Rules:

Junior Competition rules for head contact will apply to junior sparring divisions for ages 13 and under (all belts), and all color belts. New WTF rules regarding point gap and point cap will apply.

Ages 11 & Under Elite Open (All Belts) and Ages 11 & Under World Class Color Belt Divisions:

No Head Contact. Any technique contacted to the head which does not make any injury, will be given a warning. Any technique, which makes injury to the head area, will result in a one-point deduction. If the competitor cannot continue because of the injury to the head area, the attacker will be disqualified.

World Class Divisions Ages 13 and Under (Black Belts), Elite Open 12-17 Year Old Divisions (All Belts):

The competitor is allowed to kick to the facial area. **Facial kick must be light contact** with absolute control without causing any injury or excessive contact. The competitor who executes a successful technique (light contact, no injury) shall be awarded one point. Competitor who executes kick to the face which results in a minor injury shall receive a one-point deduction. The competitor who executes a kick to the face which results in the inability of the opponent to continue sparring because of injury shall be disqualified.

World Class 14-17 Year Old Black Belts: **Senior Black Belt adult rules shall apply** for this division.

Foot contact to the head will result in the award of two points for the attacker.

Note (For all Junior Divisions): Inability to continue because of fright, crying or loss of will following a kick to the head which did not cause injury does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker.

The tournament director reserves the right to modify the duration, the number of rounds, and the rest period to ensure timely completion of the tournament.

Equipment:
(Mandatory)

The following follows USAT equipment rules.

- Standard white, V-neck Taekwondo uniform (black trim for black belts only) in good condition
- Red and Blue full-body WTF/USAT chest protector (must cover back and all scoring areas)

Example:



- WTF/USAT-approved Taekwondo gloves are **MANDATORY** for 14-17 year old Black Belts and Senior Black Belts (optional for all other divisions). Must be white or red/blue corresponding with match color. Must correspond with instep color.
- WTF/USAT-approved Taekwondo Foam shin protector and instep pad and forearm protector. Minimum 1/2” thick energy-absorbing foam. Instep pad must cover top width of foot from base of toes to ankle
- Groin protection (**required** for males), worn under the uniform
- WTF/USAT-approved Taekwondo Foam head protector (white or red/blue corresponding with match color). Minimum 3/4” thick energy-absorbing foam
- Mouth guard
- Good personal hygiene (e.g., short, clean nails; clean body; groomed hair)
- No jewelry or metallic objects worn (including any kind of prescribed eye glasses/goggles)

C. OPEN TAEKWONDO CHAMPIONSHIP, OR ANY OF THEIR REGENTS, DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, MANAGERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, AFFILIATES, ATTORNEYS, SPOUSES, HEIRS, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, SUCCESSORS OR ASSIGNS. I FURTHER AGREE TO HOLD EACH OF THEM HARMLESS AND TO INDEMNIFY EACH OF THEM FROM LIABILITY ARISING FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS (INCLUDING FOR THE NEGLIGENCE OF ANY OF THEM THAT MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY, ACCIDENT, ILLNESS OR DEATH), DEMANDS, COSTS, DAMAGES, ACTIONS, CAUSES OF ACTION, OR SUITS OF ANY NATURE OR KIND THAT ARE IN ANY WAY RELATED TO MY TRAINING FOR, TRAVELING TO, PARTICIPATING IN OR RETURNING FROM U. C. BERKELEY, OR TO MY USE OF THE FACILITIES, PREMISES OR EQUIPMENT INVOLVED IN THE 40th ANNUAL U. C. OPEN TAEKWONDO CHAMPIONSHIP.

FURTHER, IN THE EVENT I AM INJURED, I GRANT PERMISSION TO ANY AND ALL OF THE LICENSED ATHLETIC TRAINERS OR DOCTORS INVOLVED IN THE 40th ANNUAL U. C. OPEN TAEKWONDO CHAMPIONSHIP TO PROVIDE ME WITH MEDICAL ASSISTANCE AND TREATMENT. FOR MYSELF, AND FOR MY HEIRS, CHILDREN, PARENTS, GUARDIANS, EXECUTORS, PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES, ASSIGNS AND ADMINISTRATORS, I FOREVER RELEASE, ACQUIT, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE ANY OF THE ORGANIZERS, VOLUNTEERS, SPONSORS, AFFILIATED ORGANIZATIONS, COACHES, INSTRUCTORS, MANAGERS, TRAINERS OR DOCTORS, OR ANY OTHER PERSONS OR ORGANIZATIONS INVOLVED IN THE 40th ANNUAL U. C. OPEN TAEKWONDO CHAMPIONSHIP, OR ANY OF THEIR REGENTS, DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, MANAGERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, AFFILIATES, ATTORNEYS, SPOUSES, HEIRS, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, SUCCESSORS OR ASSIGNS, AND TO HOLD EACH OF THEM HARMLESS AND TO INDEMNIFY EACH OF THEM FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS (INCLUDING FOR THE NEGLIGENCE OF ANY OF THEM THAT MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY, ACCIDENT, ILLNESS OR DEATH), DEMANDS, COSTS, DAMAGES, ACTIONS, CAUSES OF ACTION, OR SUITS OF ANY NATURE OR KIND THAT ARE IN ANY WAY RELATED TO ANY INJURY I SUSTAIN OR SUFFER IN CONNECTION WITH SAID MEDICAL ASSISTANCE OR TREATMENT.

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
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
