2. President's Remarks

President Russell Ahn talked about 2017 being a busy one. The 2017 Universiade will be held in Taipei, and the National Collegiate Taekwondo Championships will be held April 1-2, 2017 at the University of California, San Diego. Our High School Championships is also recognized as a national qualifier this year. The NCTA is also looking at holding a joint training camp in Korea in early June with our US National Collegiate Team.

4. 2017 NCTA Collegiate and High School Championships Update

President Ahn noted that the April 1-2 dates were approved by USA Taekwondo. Aaron Sampson of UCSD said that the venue was confirmed after some negotiation regarding the cost of the venue. The Sheraton and Marriott were identified as potential host hotels.

5. NCAA Recognition Update

Coach Antipa serves on the USA Taekwondo task force appointed by Mr. Keith Ferguson of USA Taekwondo comprised of USCT members, NCTA members and others. An introductory letter to Athletic Directors was drafted. USAT is looking at restructuring the task force to be trimmer as meetings were difficult to schedule during Fall 2016.

6. Bylaws Discussion

Senior VP Hatfield mentioned that an inclusion statement for LGBTQIA needs to be included in the bylaws, and that some transgendered athletes have competed and a formal statement needs to be included in the bylaws.

Revisions to the seeding factors for the bylaws were discussed.

After some discussion, the following seeding factors were agreed upon for use in the 2017 Selection Procedures only by a vote of 6 for and 2 against:

1. Olympics
2. Taekwondo World Championships
3. Summer World University Games (Universiade)
4. World University Taekwondo Championships
5. Pan Am Games
6. Pan Am Championships
7. United States National Team Trials
8. US Collegiate National Team Trials
9. WTF Ranking (top 100 only)
10. US Collegiate National Championships
11. US Senior National Championships
12. US Junior National Championships

7. Open Discussion

There was some discussion about potential changes to the poomsae format at the World University Games. President Ahn said that a statement would be released soon from WTF and FISU.
